Fellow APD Re-engineering Work Group Members,

At the Review Committee meeting earlier today, we realized that counties who need federal approval for their CWS related APDs will need to get those into the Project Office by November 1, 2007, before we are ready with the new process. Waiting any longer will jeopardize their ability to obtain the necessary approvals early enough in this fiscal year to purchase and claim by June 30, 2008. I volunteered to send out a note advising counties for the tight time frame. Following is the note I sent to the Social Services Directors.

Social Service Directors,

The Office of System Integration is nearing the end of the APD Re-engineering Project. They anticipate that the revised process will be finalized by mid-November with training to be scheduled shortly thereafter. An ACIN will be issued outlining the new approach and notifying you of training.

In the meantime, counties should continue to submit APDs using current instructions. Counties requesting approval for projects that must be submitted to the federal government for approval (items classified as SACWIS totaling \$100,000 or more), should submit APDs by November 1, 2007, to best ensure approval early enough in the fiscal year to allow for purchase and claiming by June 30, 2007. Federal staff are taking the full 60 days allowed for their approval (and in some cases more time) to review and respond to APDs, which is stretching the necessary timeframe out further than we experienced in FY 2006/07.

I will also send this notice to County Child Welfare Directors, CWS/CMS Oversight Committee Members, CWS/CMS Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Members, CWS/CMS Program Impact Advisory Committee (PIAC), CWDA IT Committee Members, CWDA Fiscal Committee Members, and the CWS/CMS Regional User Groups.
